WHEN ARE THE GUILD MEETINGS HELD?

We meet the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of the month with a social gathering starting at 9:30 followed by the program and the business meeting.

WHERE DOES THE GUILD MEET?

Generally, we meet at the Sedona Arts Center located at 15 Art Barn Road in the uptown area of Sedona. Occasionally there are meetings held at other locations so check the specific program and workshops listed on our website.

WHAT RESOURCES ARE AVAILABLE IN TH AREA FOR FIBER ARTISTS:

Knit Wits carries yarn and supplies and is also often a gathering place for those working on projects. Anyone is welcome to join the group. See their web site for group dates and times.

## ARE THERE MUSEUMS AND OTHER EXHIBITS OF FIBER WORK IN THE AREA?

Our guild participates in Community Demonstrations at the Sedona Heritage Museum located at 735 Jordon Road in the uptown area of Sedona on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of each month, September through June. While the focus is on spinning, any fiber artist is welcome to participate in the demonstration. The group meets from 11:00 am through 1:00 pm.

We also have exhibits at the Sedona Library in September and the Clarkdale Library in February.

The weekend of Memorial Day annually there is the Flag Wool and Fiber Festival. This year it will be held at the Arizona Historical Society Pioneer Museum in Flagstaff, June 4 and 5. The festival includes fiber animal exhibits, fiber and cultural demonstrations, a fiber arts competition and exhibit, workshops, and many vendors.
